## Just a gentle reminder

### School Uniform

Please ensure the children are wearing shoes to school not boots or trainers. We have seen a few of these over the last few weeks.

### Jewellery

For health and safety reasons we do not allow children to wear jewellery. The exceptions to this rule are ear-ring studs in pierced ears, and small objects of religious significance. Children are required to remove any items during PE lessons to prevent them from causing injury. Please note: Teachers are not permitted to remove earrings.

### Hair Ornaments, Make-up and Nail Varnish

Hair bands, ribbons/bows or 'scrunchies' should be plain and either blue, black or red. Hair bands should not have large flowers attached. Make up and nail varnish should not be worn to school unless for an out of school hours function, for example a school disco. Extreme hairstyles are not appropriate for school. The use of styling products should be kept to a minimum and children should not have decorative patterns cut into their hair or have hair coloured or dyed.
